What Computer Network Support Specialists Do

Computer support specialists provide help and advice to computer users and organizations. These specialists either support computer networks or they provide technical assistance directly to computer users.

Network/Technical Support Specialists typically do the following:

- Test and evaluate existing network systems, perform regular maintenance to ensure that networks operate correctly
- Troubleshoot local area networks (LANs), wide area networks (WANs), and Internet systems

Technical support specialists may provide assistance to the organization's computer users through phone, email, or in-person visits.
